Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate "Gaudete Sunday." Gaudete means "rejoice" in Latin. Today we rejoice because the Lord is near, *God is coming to save us!*

Today I'd like to share with you an excerpt of an article written by Emily Stimpson Chapman that reminds us of what life was like before Jesus and why we ought to rejoice over His coming.

She writes:

"Once, long ago, the world was black as night. The sun still shone above, but inside the hearts of men, all was dark.

That darkness was the darkness of a soul with no hope for heaven. The gates to Paradise had long since been closed. Death, sorrow, and loss were everywhere. Sin was everywhere. And there was no way out.

Unlike now, there was no Baptism to restore God's life to the soul, no Confession to wipe the soul's slate clean. Nor were there any images of God, dying on a cross for love of us, to comfort and console.


