

Evangelization Corner

Dear Friends,

In today's Gospel, we hear about Peter's profession of faith followed by Jesus' plan to build the Church. Sometimes we forget that the Church is not simply a community of members but of **believers**. You and I are a part of this community of believers. Do we, like Peter, really believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God, sent by the Father to redeem us and to bring us into His Kingdom? It's easy to skim through this column and give a flippant "yes" to this question, but it's good to courageously examine ourselves to see if our lives really conform to this belief. If we truly believe in the mission and saving work of Jesus Christ, we would not want to keep this good new to ourselves! Our work in evangelization hinges upon our response to Jesus' question :who do you say that I am?"

Below is an excerpt from an Angelus address given by Pope Francis in 2014. In his remarks, he urges us to honestly evaluate our faith and belief in Jesus Christ:

"Todays Gospel challenges each of us: How is your Faith? Let Each of us answer in our hearts. How is your faith? How is it? What does the Lord find in our hearts: a firm heart, like a rock? Or a heart like sand, that is doubtful, mistrustful, unbelieving? It would do us good to think about this throughout the day. If the Lord finds in our hearts a faith — I won't say perfect, but sincere, genuine, then He will see in us, to, the living rocks on which He builds His community. For this community, the foundation stone is Christ, the unique cornerstone. For his part, Peter is the rock, as the visible foundation of the unity of the Church; but every baptized person is called to offer to Jesus his or her own faith , poor but sincere, so that He can continue to build His Church, today, in every part of the world."



You will need your most recent federal tax return, payroll reports, IRS W9 to accept payment, Receipts or invoices to substantiate expenses incurred. 
