Shut-Ins: Please call us.



History of the Sacred Heart Church in Arban

The first congregation in Arban was organized in April 1873 in an area called "Young's Settlement by Rev. Joseph Vill, O.S.B., of St. John's Abby. The first mass was celebrated in the Sebastian Wiedmann home where the first baptism also took place; Charles, son of Michael and Margaret Hartung. In the winter of 1884 a small church was built of logs. Homestead laws wouldn't allow land to be donated to a church but Francis Young promised 10 acres and Denis Wiedmann and William Luckeroth both promised four acres and \$25 each. By 1887 a second church needed to by built that was 26x50 and was again built with logs. In 1893 there were 45 families, all German. The final church costing \$5000 was built in 1904 and dedicated that November by Bishop Trobec. Sacred Heart was always a mission of another parish and various pastors from St. Joseph, St. Wendel, Opole and St. Mary's served. But in 1924, the care of Sacred Heart was transferred to the pastor of Immaculate Conception Parish. This was a big change because the mostly German parishioners of Arban accepted a Polish pastor opening the door for the start of Catholic unity. Today the Arban Record Books are kept along side those of All Saints in care of All Saints-St. Mary's.





In August of 1989, the Arban Church was closed. The building itself was moved to the Albany Pioneer Days grounds. It was de-listed and is no longer a Catholic Church but still remains a historical building. Weather permitting, Mass is held at the steps that still remain at the original site in Arban.



St. Gregory the Great St. Gregory's early life in 540 AD was in Rome during a time of a Plague, Ostrogoth Barbarians attack and followed by The Franks invasion. To escape the turmoil, his family moved to property they owned in Sicily.

Afterwards, during a more peaceful time, St. Gregory was able to study law and at 33 became the prefect of Rome, just as his father before him.

After his father died, St. Gregory's converted the family villa to a monastery and became a monk. In 590, he was elected Pope. He was reluctant to take this position but relented to his duty. During his Papacy he put emphasis on the mission of caring for the poor and bringing people to Jesus. During a famine he provided free food and often he ate with the poor. Because of his actions, he and the Church were greatly respected. Upon his death in 604 AD he was immediately made a Saint. His remains are buried in St. Peter's Basilica, Rome.
