Right relationship with the context of Marriage

The church wants what's best for your soul! Why?

What's best for your soul will most effectively help you on your journey to heaven and in turn will help others that you are walking the journey with here on earth.

The Catholic Church believes that you cannot earn your way to heaven but only through God's Grace will we ultimately be saved.

The Universal or Local Church spells out the parameters of what they believe to be correct or in Right Relationship. Some examples include: marriage is between one woman and one man, their vows are about permanence, faithfulness, openness to life, it is a community celebration not private, the preparation period is a minimum of six months, no living together in the preparation period, or that the actual Marriage has to take place in a church building to be valid....

Three scenarios of not being in Right Relationship that often happen and what would be the correct solutions are:

Marriage by Justice of the Peace. So, if you got married without a Priest or Deacon presiding, outside of a Catholic Church building (without permission of the Bishop), without an approved Catholic Marriage Preparation course, or before an annulment was granted from a former marriage:

Consequence: Now, not in Right Relationship because you have chosen to step out of the normal procedures that the teachings lay out. Therefore, you lose some of the normal rights. You should not receive Communion but can worship within the community. Because you understand that it is wrong, you must start the process of reconciling with the church community and not continue in this incorrect behavior. How do you get back into Right Relationship? 1. Contact your Priest 2. Go to Confession 3. Begin the process of getting your Marriage Blessed in the Church which includes classes, paperwork, retreats approved by the Diocese that are required for a normal Marriage.

Marriage of a non-Catholic to a Catholic Often times it happens that when one was married in an approved mixed marriage in the Church, the non-Catholic party starts receiving the Eucharist without being in full communion with the Catholic Church. The non-Catholic party should continue to worship with the spouse and family but should not be receiving the Eucharist or other sacraments. How do I get back in Right Relationship? 1. Contact the church 2. Pray about whether you are called to become Catholic (we would be happy if you joined us fully) 3. Sign up for RCIA classes to explore this option 4. or stay non-Catholic but live according to the traditions you claim 5. Continue to pray for unity amongst the different traditions so that someday we will be one 6. Continue to physically come to worship every Sunday with your family.

Divorced Catholics who begin dating again without the Annulment granted by the Church.

Often because of varied circumstances, a civil divorce happens and it leaves the Catholic party not knowing what to do to be in Right Relationship with the Church. One should not date until the church has granted you the full freedom to do so, otherwise you are still considered married in the eyes of the church to the former party. How do I get back in Right Relationship: 1. Contact your priest 2.Start the Annulment process 3. Stop receiving communion until the annulment is granted. 4. Continue to worship every Sunday at Mass with your community.

Evangelization Corner

Dear Friends,

A few years ago I had the privilege of going on pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Walking along the shore of the Sea of Galilee was a particularly moving experience for me. On that sacred ground where Jesus walked when He called His first disciples, I was mindful of my own call to follow Him. Just as the disciples were invited to leave behind the known for the unknown, I had this keen understanding that I was called to do the same. On the shores of the sea, however, with only my toes dipped into the shallow water, this call into the unknown still seemed safe. It's easy to follow Jesus on the shore, but what happens when He calls us into the deep waters of faith?

In today's Gospel, Peter receives a new call on the same sea. This time it is a call to have a more determined and radical trust in Jesus. In this account, Jesus again says "come." Peter immediately responds, and through Jesus' power is able to do the impossible by walking on water! But in the chaos of the storm, Peter quickly forgets Jesus' presence and Divine Power. Relying on his own strength, he begins to panic and sink. How often have we found ourselves in the same situation? When we forget Jesus' presence and strength in our storms, our lives become plagued with fear, worry, and angst.

Every storm in our life is a call to enter into the deep waters of faith. Every storm is an invitation to deeper trust and more mature faith. It's also an opportunity for us to grow in ways we never thought possible. In the storms of our lives, Jesus calls us to "come." We can't always see Him, but He is always there, ready to catch us when we sink, challenging us to believe that through Him, nothing is impossible.


