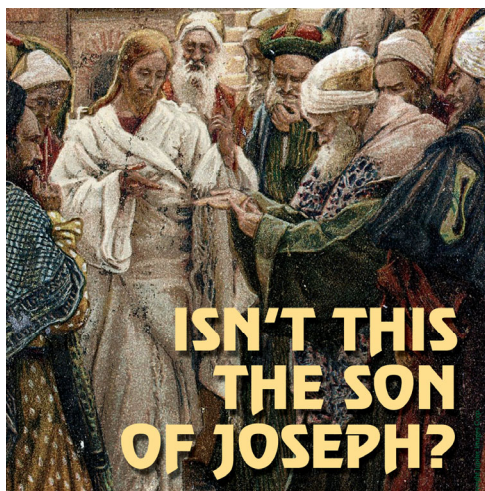

update our census. Thank you.

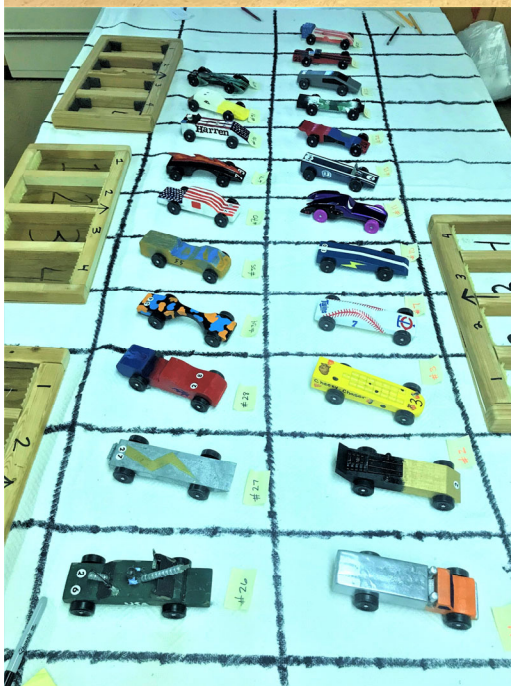

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Covid Precautions

Diocesan requirements for Covid precautions are as follows:

1. Effective January 24th, face coverings are requested by the Bishop for all indoor parish activities regardless of vaccination status, including attending Masses, faith formation classes, and other gatherings.
2. The masking requirement applies to members of the assembly, choirs, altar servers, and other group situations. Priests and deacons may choose to wear face coverings throughout the Mass but are only required to do so during the processional, recessional, and distribution of Holy Communion. Extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion and ushers must wear masks. Lectors and cantors may remove their masks when reading or singing.
3. He encourages limiting group events and meetings as much as possible for parishioners and staff during this period - please keep an eye on the bulletin to see if any upcoming events or groups are being cancelled or postponed.
4. The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation **remains in place**. The exceptions to this would be: if you believe your health will be significantly compromised, you are a caregiver to someone who is sick or homebound, or you are 65 or older. Father will continue livestreaming Sunday Mass for those who are sick or otherwise unable to attend in person. Please remember that your pastor is a messenger of the Bishop. Pray for your pastors and write to the Bishop for your concerns. You are always welcome to celebrate here with us in the Eucharist! Visit: www.stcdio.org to read the entire letter from the Bishop.

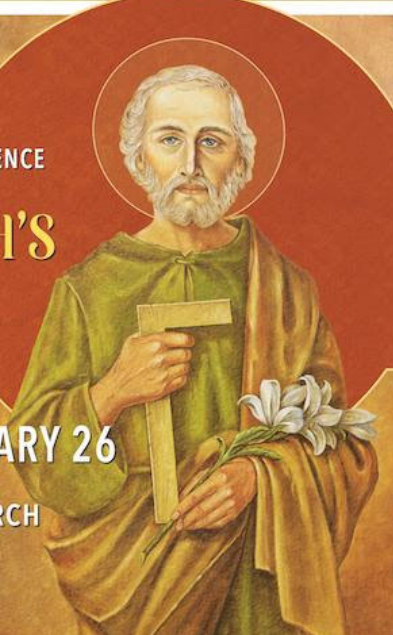

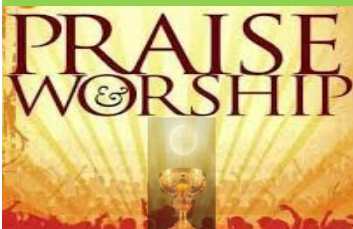
