Evangelization Corner

Dear Friends,

In honor of Trinity Sunday, I'd like to introduce you to one of my favorite saints, St. Elizabeth of the Trinity. St. Elizabeth of the Trinity was a discolored Carmelite nun from Dijon, France who died at the age of 26. She was canonized by Pope Francis in October of 2016 and her spiritual writings have been a rich source of grace for many people.

The doctrine of the Trinity can be a tough mystery for us to tackle! But for St. Elizabeth, the Blessed Trinity wasn't an abstract idea "out there," but an ever present reality within her. Through her writings, St. Elizabeth reminds us that we begin to live our ultimate end - union with the Trinity - here and now in the center of our hearts where the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit begin to dwell at the moment of our Baptism. St. Elizabeth desired everyone to know that we are all called to a great and beautiful purpose: to become a dwelling place of God's presence in the world.

Here is an excerpt from the prayer "Holy Trinity, Whom I Adore" written by St. Elizabeth: *"O my God, Trinity whom I adore, let me entirely forget myself that I may abide in You, still and peaceful as if my God, but that each moment may take me further into the depths of Your mystery! Pacify my soul! Make it Your heaven, Your beloved home and place of Your repose; let me never leave You there alone, but may I be ever attentive, ever alert in my faith, ever adoring and all given up to Your creative action."*

On this Trinity Sunday, let's ask St. Elizabeth of the Trinity to intercede for us so that we can become more aware of the mystery of the Trinity dwelling within us.
