New Evangelization Corner By Deacon Dan Dullinger

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Last week was a wonderful blessing in so many ways, thank you! Whether you were at one of the Masses, we met in person, prayed together, or shared stories, we got to know each other a little better.

Father Gregory, as you know, hired me to be an *evangelist*, but this is not just my job, we are all called to be evangelists by our baptism. With Lent just around the corner, this is a good time to evaluate our evangelistic efforts. Ask yourself the following questions. Am I being the evangelist I am called to be within the context of my life? Who has God brought into my life, at school, at work, my neighborhood, or in my family, that He wants me to share my faith with. You may be wondering how you can do this, below are some ideas.

- Pray and read Scripture daily.
- Regularly celebrate the sacraments, especially Reconciliation and in Sunday Mass.
- Trust in the Holy Spirit to give you the grace needed to witness and share your faith with others.
- Pray and fast for our Holy Father, bishops, priests, religious, and all those who serve the Church.
- Attend diocese-wide faith formation events, like retreats and catechetical days, the Eucharistic Revival events, etc.
- Join in the celebration of diocese-wide liturgies, such as Marriage Sunday, Mass for Life, and the Rite of Election.
- Regularly check our diocesan and faith community websites, the bulletin, and social media outlets.
- Participate in direct service opportunities and legislative advocacy initiatives through your state Catholic Conference.
- Support missionaries and missionary efforts.
 Promote Catholic schools.

Remember the words of Peter: "Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope" (1 Pt 3:15).

Why do we practice Fasting?

Fasting consists of having one regular meal during the day or two smaller meals that do not equal a regular meal in size. It's main purpose is for us to live in spirit of repentance and turning away from sin and back to God.

What is Abstinence?

On Fridays, we refrain from eating meat since Jesus sacrificed his flesh for us on Good Friday.

Why no meat?

Traditionally, meat was more expensive and eaten only during times of feasting and rejoicing.

Why can we eat fish? Fish doesn't belong to the "flesh meats" as it is a cold blooded animal. The Latin word "caro" from which we get words like carnivore applies to flesh meat and does not include fish.

When?

Fasting and abstinence are for Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Abstinence is for Fridays in Lent.

Abstinence for Catholics age 14+. Fasting is for Catholics ages 18-58 with some exceptions.
