New Evangelization Corner

To be happy in the next life, we must accept the cross in this life.

This past week on Tuesday we celebrated the apparitions of Our Lady of Lourdes. One of the better-known appari-

tions of Our Lady took place in Lourdes, France in 1858. The shrine there today continues to be one of the most popular Marian shrines in the world. Thousands of people visit this shrine every year, a special place of devotion to Our Lady. In this apparition, a miraculous spring of water welled up from the ground at the apparition site. Thousands of verified and recorded physical healings, not to mention countless unknow emotional and spiritual healings, have taken place and are attributed to this holy site and this spring of water.

Beginning with her first apparition of February 11, 1858, Mary appeared eighteen times to Bernadette Soubirous, now Saint Bernadette, a girl of only fourteen years of age. When Bernadette asked the Lady who she was, she received the reply, "I am the Immaculate Conception."

So, what does that mean, Immaculate Conception?

(Pope Pius IX) "The Most Blessed Virgin Mary was from the first moment of her conception, by the singular, grace and privilege of almighty God, and in view of the merits of Christ Jesus the Savior of the human race, preserved immune from all stain of original sin". Mary received the saving grace of the Cross of Christ, before it happened in space and time.

This heavenly message of this apparition can be summed up in the following points: confirmation of the Church' teaching (dogma) on the Immaculate Conception, to live the virtues of Christian poverty [of heart] and humility, to be happy in the next life, we must accept the cross in this life, prayer and especially to pray the Rosary.
