

Saint Teresa of Lisieux Feast Day: Oct. 1st Patron saint of: missionaries, florists and aviators. Pray for us!

- 1. Saint Therese was born in France in 1873 to pious Catholic parents. Her parents, Louis and Zelie Martin, are saints too!
- 2. Her mother described Saint Therese as an "incredibly stubborn" child and spoke of her frequent tantrums. Therese describes a turning point on Christmas Day in 1886 when she had a "complete conversion."
- 3. Her mother died of breast cancer when Therese was only four years old, leaving her father and four older sisters to raise her.
- 4. Pope Leo XIII said she could enter Carmel "if God wills it." Her bishop then granted her special permission at age 15.
- 5. The "Little Way" of Saint Therese is a message of spirituality that focuses on simple childlike trust in Jesus.
- 6. Saint Therese of Lisieux died at age 24. Her final words were, "My God, I love you!"



Here's what to do

Scam Calls: Don't send money. Never send anyone cash or pay with gift cards or wire transfers. You won't get it back.

Charity Fraud: Take your time. Don't trust your caller ID. Scammers use technology to make any name or number appear on caller ID.

Job & Money-Making Scams: Stop. Check it out. Never pay money to earn money. And don't share personal information.

Business Impersonator Scams: Stop. If you get an unexpected call, email, text, or message on social mediaeven if it looks like it's from a business you know-don't' click any links. And don't call phone numbers they give you. These are often scams.

Health Insurance Scams: Stop. Check it out. Before you share your information, call Medicare (1-800-Medicare).

Please Report Scams: Go online: ReportFraud.ftc.gov or Call: 1-877-382-4357. Your report can help protect other people. By reporting fraud, you can help the FTC's investigators identify the scammers and stop them before they can get someone's hard-earned money. It really makes a difference.

Religious Ed. / Confirmation Preparation at Another Parish:

For a variety of reasons, some of our parish families may choose to have their child prepare for and receive the Sacrament of Confirmation at a different parish. We understand that family logistics, school schedules, or other factors can make it more convenient to participate in a program elsewhere.

We support your family's decision and want to ensure a smooth process. To receive Confirmation at another parish, it is important to communicate with both our parish and the parish hosting the classes and each Pastor.

Whatever Parish you are registered, that Priest is responsible for your soul.

You must officially register and participate in the Confirmation program of the other parish. Please inform our Parish Office of your intentions.

We will need to have a record of your child's sacramental preparation for our files.

Once your child is Confirmed, the other parish will send a 'Notification of Confirmation' to our Parish Office so the Sacrament can be recorded.

Understanding the costs

Most parishes charge a fee for their Confirmation program. This fee is separate from our parish's regular Faith Formation or tuition fees. You will be responsible for paying the Confirmation fee directly to the parish where your child attends classes.

<u>Costs often cover</u>: Program materials, a Confirmation retreat and other program activities.

<u>Fees vary</u>: Each parish sets its own fee structure. Be sure to check with the host parish for their specific costs and payment schedule.

Assistance available: If the cost is a concern, please speak with the Director of Faith Formation or the pastor at the host parish. Most parishes offer financial assistance confidentially to families in need. For more information, or to notify us of your plans, please contact our Parish Office.
