Our Lady of Czestochowa, is a very famous painting of the Blessed Virgin holding the Child Jesus. Under this title, Mary is the Patron and Protector of Poland. The darkening of the image comes from centuries of being hidden and soot and smoke illuminating the icon. Mary gestures toward Jesus, guiding the attention away from her and gesturing toward Jesus, pointing to Jesus the source of salvation.

Legend has it that it was painted by St. Luke on a piece of a cedar table top built by St. Joseph. Some say it is part of the table used at the Last Supper. All Saints-St. Hedwig's has a replica in the back of the church to behold.

Save a Soul Indulgences for All Souls Week

An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from the first to the eighth of November; on other days it is partial.

A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who on the day dedicated to All Souls [November 2, as well as on the Sunday preceding or following, and on All Saints' Day] piously visit a church. In visiting the church it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited.

To acquire a plenary indulgence it is necessary also to fulfill the following three conditions: sacramental Confession, Eucharistic communion, and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father. The three conditions may be fulfilled several days before or after the performance of the visit; it is, however, fitting that communion be received and the prayer for the intention of the Holy Father be said on the same day as the visit.

The condition of praying for the Intention of the Holy Father is fully satisfied by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary. A plenary indulgence can be acquired only once in the course of the day.

He had a vision of a stag with a crucifix between its antlers and heard a voice. After this experience he renounced his former life and became a monk.
