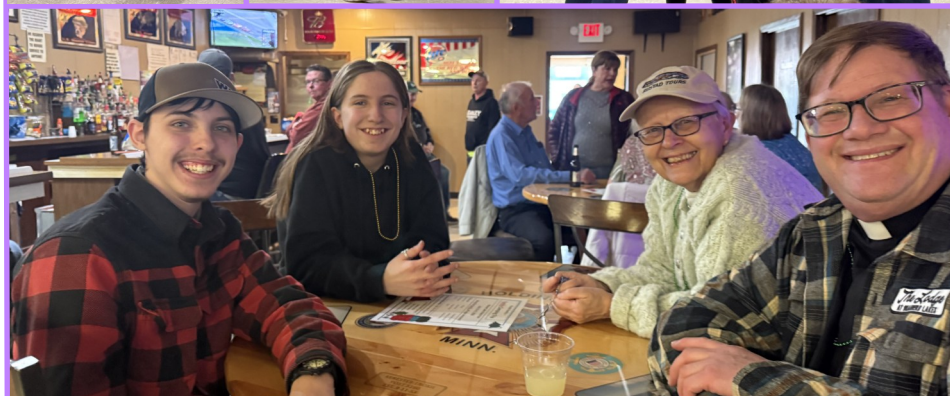

New Evangelization Corner Doug Herbek

First Sunday of Lent



"Whoever does not love a brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen." - 1 John 4:20

"God created man in his image; in the divine image he created him; male and female he created them." Genesis 1:27

When we forget this core truth, we tend to hurt each other with our words and sometimes choose not to speak up after hearing such words, leaving someone in a difficult situation or feeling belittled.

In contrast to saying nothing, Cardinal Cupich expressed shock and outrage over a recent social media posting. He called it viciously racist because it depicted them as less than human. He defended their dignity as made in God's image.

To heal, we must acknowledge that all of us are made in God's image. For us to heal, we need to step in and stop people from degrading others, and announce that they have no right to try to pull others down. Then we will have made it clear that such mistreatment should not occur. In doing so, we will have affirmed the dignity of our neighbor. Seeing the image of God in our neighbor, we will love our neighbor, and through the love of God in us, we will heal as individuals and as a nation.

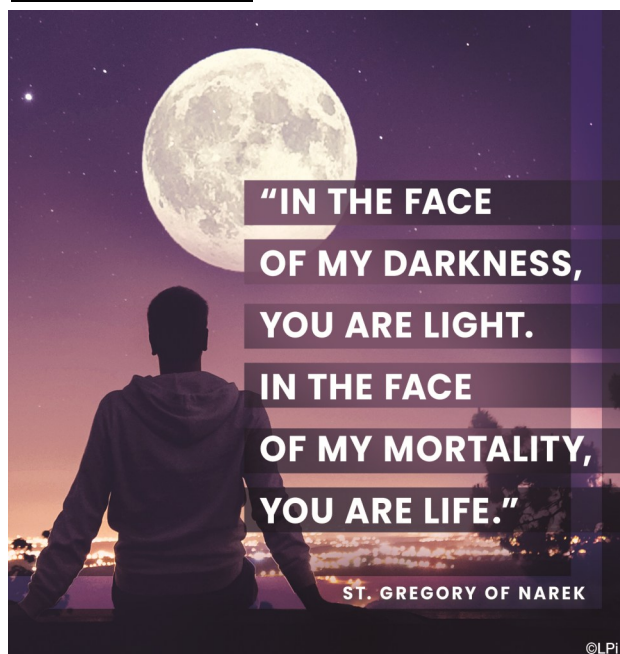

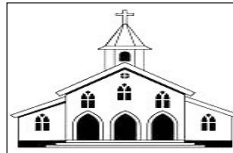
